

“Aufholen nach Corona im Fach Englisch” – Diagnosis and Support Programme

For this programme, Oxford University Press applies the following data protection regulations:

- All student data used on the **Oxford Placement Test** (Oxford English Testing) and **Oxford Reading Club** platforms is anonymised. No personal information from students (ie. first names, last names or emails addresses) is collected, used or stored on either platform.
- Any personal data within the **Oxford Placement Test** (Oxford English Testing) and **Oxford Reading Club** platforms is stored within the hosting provider’s database and backup systems and is not synchronised or replicated within any other systems. These servers and systems are hosted in London, UK for Oxford Placement Test and in Tokyo, Japan for Oxford Reading Club. The hosting provider manages all data in line with ISO 27001 standard and conforms to EU GDPR. The UK and Japan are recognized by the EU as having an [adequate level of data protection](#)
- Oxford University Press will not use any data collected from teachers taking part in the “Aufholen nach Corona” Programme for marketing or sales purposes, or for any commercial offers outside of the programme.
